A: The *NOAA Research and Development Vision Areas:2020-2026* characterizes the priorities and guidance for NOAA's R&D activities for the next seven years. This is the fourth plan of its kind at NOAA.

A: The *Vision* sets the foci for NOAA's R&D activities for 2020-2026.
